

Warbler Woods Plant List, May 2014 Edition

This list includes plants seen at Warbler Woods (Schaezler property) between May 2005 and May 2014. Scientific names generally follow the USDA PLANTS database (<http://plants.usda.gov/java/>) or the flora of North-Central Texas (Diggs, Lipscomb & O'Kennon, 1999), with synonymy from pertinent manuals (e.g., Correll & Johnston, 1970) appearing in parentheses. Common names follow various sources listed in the references cited at the end of the list. Codes in Nativity column: E = exotic, i.e., not native to Texas; N = native to Texas; N+ = endemic to (found only in) Texas. Codes in Form column: AQ = aquatic forb; FA = annual forb; FAV = annual vine forb; FB = biennial forb; FP = perennial forb; FPV = perennial vine forb; GA = annual grass or grasslike plant; GP = perennial grass or grasslike plant; PP = perennial fern or fern ally; S = shrub; T = tree; WV = woody vine.
